

CACI's mission software approach utilizes scalable, Agile portfolio management and seamless, rapid vendor onboarding, to build a dynamic vendor-agnostic ecosystem that delivers the best solution for each requirement. As an experienced ecosystem integrator, we manage tactical execution across all vendors from large OEMs to small capability providers. We use service level agreements, with standard metrics analysis across the contract, to ensure quality and acceptance.

Software Development, Integration, and Reuse - Open Hosting Platform (OHP)

CACI provides a mission-agnostic, government-owned open hosting platform to accelerate system of systems integration, reduce development cost and provide full life-cycle management. The OHP consists of four components which can be used individually or in combination: infrastructure and platform as a services (IPaaS), data and knowledge management services, mission management services (MMS), user interface and experience (UI/UX). The OHP enables seamless integration of multiple software architectures to adapt to diverse mission requirements and provides common software infrastructure services to accelerate mission app development.

OHP provides a common UI to mission apps to improve operator productivity and reduce training costs, while also enabling access to native UIs to support advanced operations. The MMS provides hybrid system control patterns with both centralized and federated resource control based on system needs. The OHP provides its own IPaaS layer, app integration software development kits and guides (SDK/SDG) combine with automated test tools and data sets to reduce workloads for all integrators.
